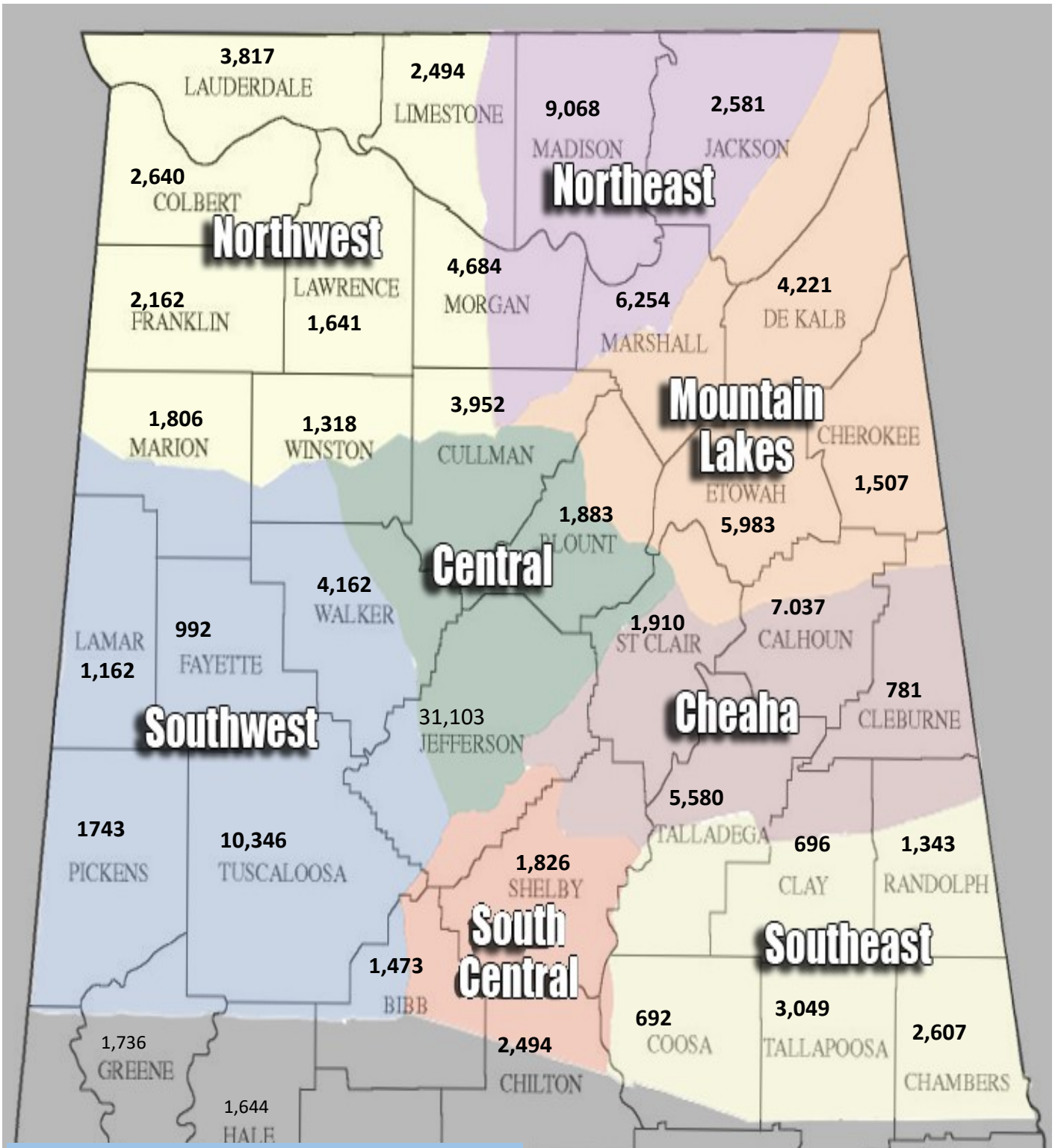


NAC Pan-Methodist Campaign for OUR Children in Poverty: 2017 Report
